SEAOC strongly supports the Taxpayers for Fair Competition Initiative which has qualified for the November General Election ballot. The initiative removes current constitutional roadblocks to enable public sector use of private sector services (“contracting out”) without mandating such procurement. It was developed by the private sector design industry.
